A main square of Wrocław, where urban life is concentrated around late-Gothic town hall, attracts attention by its renewed townhouses. Close neighbourhood of town hall is also worth visiting because of places such as Salt square, famous Świdnicka street or cobblet alley Jatki, where from the XII century meat from the municipal slaughterhouse was sold. An original monument In Memory of Animals for Slaughter reminds about it.

Panorama of Ractawice



The panoramic painting, depicting the Battle of Ractawice, painted on 15 x 114 m canvas by Jan Styka and Wojciech Kossak, is located in specially built rotunda. 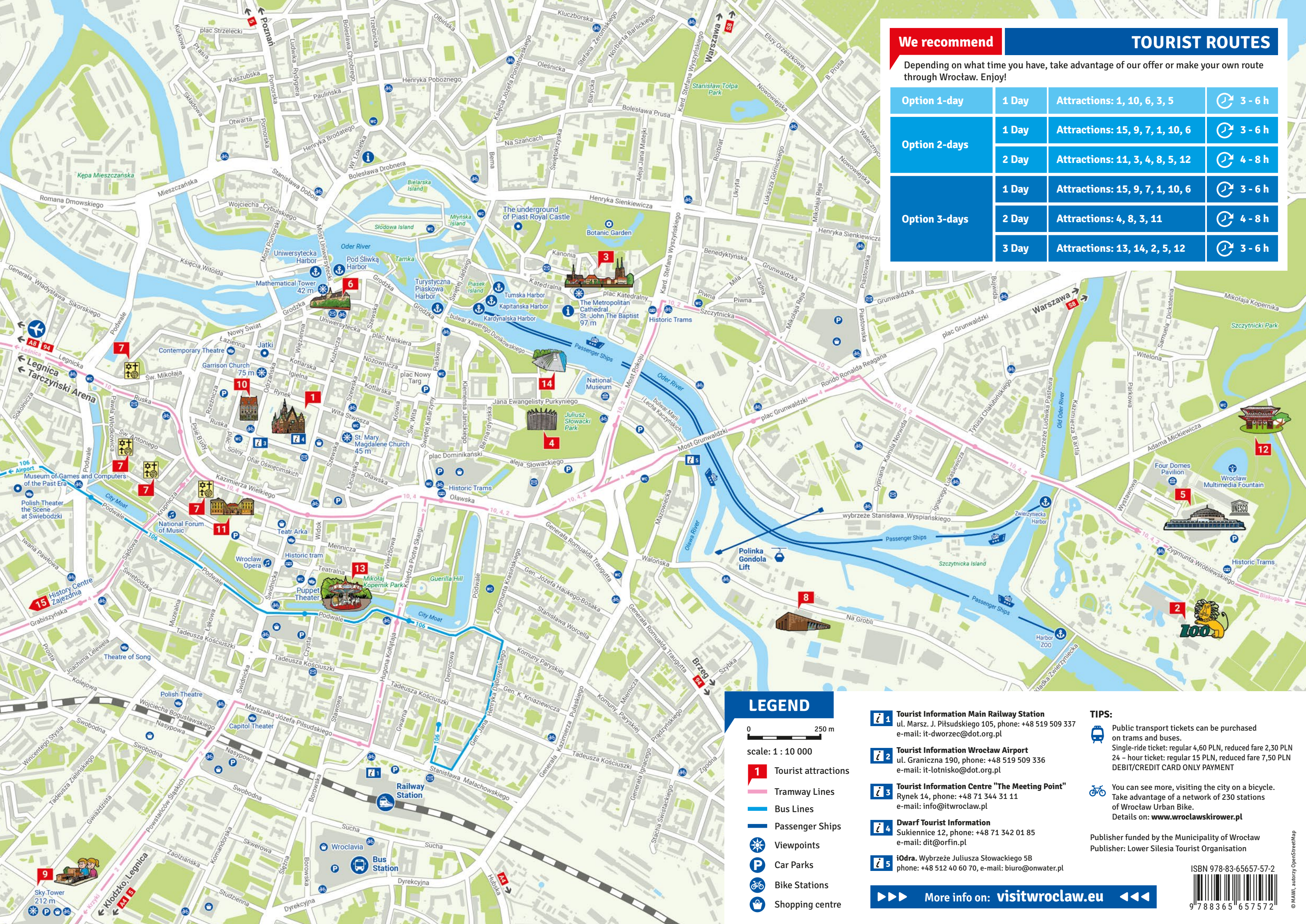
